Remembering Subhash Chandra Bose

125th Birth Anniversary Celebration

Life loses half of its interest if there is no struggle, if there are no risks to be taken.
- Subhash Chandra Bose

Special online assemblies were held across Vikhe Patil Memorial School, Pune to celebrate the Parakram Diwas- 125th birth anniversary of Subhash Chandra Bose. A special assembly was planned under the guidance of principal Mrinalini for the students from lower primary section to senior classes with an intent to provide brief information about this great leader whose patriotism was defiant.

At the lower primary section, the celebrations started with sharing the thought for the day, as he very much believed that, "Freedom is not given, it is taken." Greatly influenced by the teachings of Swami Vivekananda, Netaji, was a model of diversity by region, ethnicity, religion and even gender. Use of slogans like "Jai Hind" and "Dilli Chalo" inspired many Indians to strive for freedom. He revived the Indian National Army or the Azad Hind Fauj under his leadership.

A roleplay was performed by class III students with to help our students familiarise and engage themselves with the significance of the day.

Nisha Kulkarni of class IV gave an insight into the life and achievements of the great personality. The students watched a short film to know more about Netaji's role in India's struggle for freedom. After this, Vedika Raundhal recited a poem which was dedicated to all the freedom fighters who have laid down their lives and made countless sacrifices for our nation. After a brief prologue, the students of class V dedicated time to watch a very enriching video which enabled them to know and understand the legendary personality and his contributions to the country. The special assembly pro-



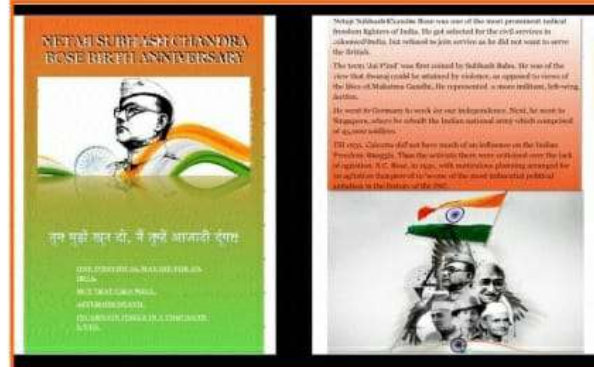

gressed further as the students paid a musical tribute to the gem of the nation who will be treasured forever by marching towards patriotism as they tuned in to the catchy "Kadam Kadam Badhayee Ja...", the regimental quick march of Netaji's Azad Hind Fauj, then, and now, the Indian National Army. The special event concluded as the students discussed and shared their perceptions about what national pride means to them, thereby promising themselves to inculcate Netaji's sense of patriotism- what our country truly needs in these current times.

The presentation by class VI included a speech, poems in various languages and videos on the legacy of Subhash Chandra Bose. A brief description on the early life of Subhash Chandra Bose was presented by the participant. Students also presented the Hindi poem- Khooni Hastakshar. Students of class VII mentioned some facts on Netaji's life and recited a poem in Bengali. The session ended with a beautiful documentary on Netaji's life followed by the national anthem, a flute recital. The students of class VII recited poems in English Hindi highlighting the valour and heroism of Bose. The event progressed with a mar-

velous dramatic mono act in Hindi that depicted a part of a historic moment from Netaji's life in the formation of the Azad Hind Sena.

A few unknown facts about Netaji's life were shared by the students of class IX. Soham Kulkarni performed a mono act as Subhas Chandra Bose.

Class XI had a power point presentation by Shreyya Mulye bringing out the major events of Netaji's life. The formative years of his life was explained by Kedar Kenjalkar. Videos of various events like the Haripura Congress session of 1938, Netaji being welcomed in Singapore, Netaji's speech-

es were a part of the PPT which added to the celebration. This was followed by recitation of the poem 'Khooni Hastakshar' written by Shri Gopal Prasad Vyas, recited by Shreeya Mulye. Posters made by Srujan Purohit and Sujal Gandhi were a visual treat. The assembly had varied facts such as speech, poetry, special quotes documentary on Netaji's life and poster presentation. Students paid their tribute and gained valuable lessons about life from the programme.

Youngest pianist plays the National Anthem & other songs

Recognised by World Record India, Raghav Malpani of Junior KG from Vikhe Patil Memorial School, Pune has set a new record as the Youngest pianist playing the national anthem and multiple songs.

4-year-old Raghav's keen interest in music led him to learn piano without any professional help. He started learning piano before turning 4. His mother and elder sister are his first piano teachers. He learnt to play the piano just by listening to the tunes played by his mother and sister, even when not knowing the lyrics of the same.

This child prodigy can effortlessly play various songs and the national anthem. He has also performed live on various Facebook groups like Taare Zameen par, Marwaris, etc. He also played live at the Ganesh festival.

Noting his remarkable abilities, World Record India has recorded his name as the youngest pianist. He has his own YouTube channel named, 'Raghav - The Rising Sensation'. He absolutely adores all kinds of music. His abilities have been highly appreciated by a lot of people, including his school teachers and Mrinalini, the principal of his school.

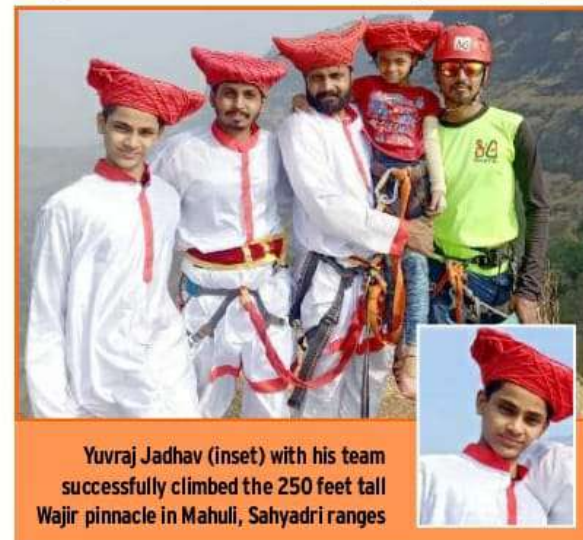

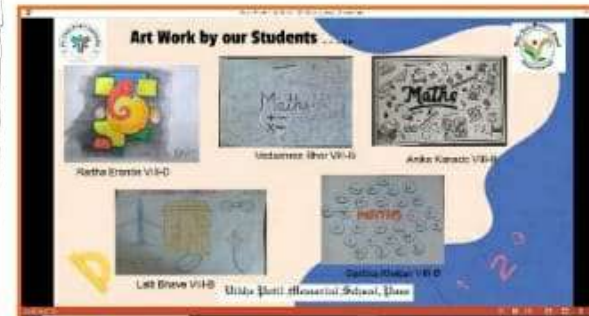
Yuvraj Jadhav (inset) with his team successfully climbed the 250 feet tall Wajir pinnacle in Mahuli, Sahyadri ranges

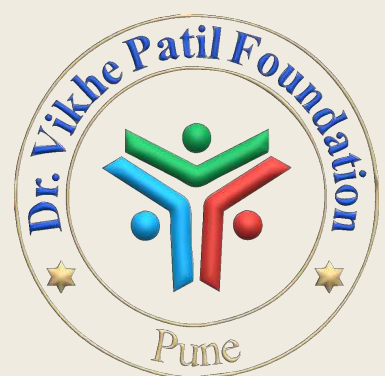
