## All About National Youth Day!

National Youth Day, also known as Vivekananda Jayanti, is celebrated on January 12, on the birthday of Swami Vivekananda. In 1984 the Government of India declared this day as National Youth Day and since then, it is celebrated annually with a great deal of enthusiasm. The Government of India quoted that "the philosophy of Swamiji and the ideals for which he lived and worked could be a great source of inspiration for the Indian youth."

National Youth Day is observed all over India at schools and colleges, with processions, speeches, music, youth conventions, seminars, presentations, etc.

Swami Vivekananda personified the eternal energy of the youth and their restless quest for truth. It is said that work must be done by awakening the youth to his ideologies, thoughts and energy to rekindle the eternal message of this great patriot and son of India. His thoughts were strongly influenced by his Guru, Sri Ramakrishna, who had a spiritual and very broad outlook towards life.

He believed that if you have an idea and want to implement it in life, you need to focus primarily on it and work tirelessly for the same. And soon, you shall attain what you had envisioned in mind.

## Some Lesser Known Facts About Swami Vivekanand

Swami Vivekananda had an affinity for music from a young age. He was a qualified classical musician, trained in dhrupad. He could also play musical instruments like Sitar and dholak, among others. Besides music, he was also an avid reader and was enthusiastic about sports and physical activities.

Known for his eloquence, Swami Vivekananda scored 47% at the university entrance level examination and 46% in the Intermediate Arts.

## A Speech Delivered At Chicago...

September 11, 2021 marked the 129th anniversary of Swami Vivekananda's historic speech at the World Parliament of Religions in Chicago. On this day in 1893, Swamiji delivered a powerful speech at the first Parliament of the World's Religions in which he spoke about tolerance, religious acceptance and the need to abolish all forms of fanaticism - issues that find relevance even today.

Through his speech, Swami Vivekananda introduced Hinduism to the western world - the religion which he said has taught the world both, tolerance and universal acceptance. Discarding the idea of religious superiority, he propagated a message of universal brotherhood. The same speech earned Swami Vivekananda a standing ovation for two minutes and went on to establish him as the greatest figure in the Parliament of World Religions, and India as the mother of religions.

In the next few moments, Raban Muradali and Anil Saxena will present the same speech of Swami Vivekananda at the Chicago convention in 1893, showcasing how he became a major force in bringing Hinduism to the status of a major world religion in the late 19th century, and the relevance of his thoughts and beliefs in the present times.
