Example of calculating

Weightage



Unit Test 1

Marks scored = 30.5/50Weightage = out of 10 30.5/5 = 6.1

Sum of best 2 of 3/20

6.1+6.9=13/20

Weightage = Out of 5

13/4 = 3.25

Unit test 2
Marks scored =
34.5/50
Weightage = Out of 10
34.5/5 = 6.9

Terminal Exam

Marks scored = 38/80

Weightage = Out of 10

38/8=4.75

The goal is to encourage students to think and apply concepts, thereby building their proficiency in mathematics within a fun, exciting, competitive yet rigorous framework




GLOBALLYREADY


